



Sailmaker's Instructions for the use of Kiwi Slides

For Headsail and Furler use, Kiwi Slides are designed to replace both "Jib Hanks" and "Luff Tapes". The Kiwi Slide has the advantage in always having a contained luff. There are four sizes of Kiwi Slide each of which corresponds to one of the Reef-Rite furling system models – 6/40, 7/50, 8/60 and 9/70.

The Kiwi Slides supplied with your Reef-Rite furling system are the correct size for your installation. For other brand furling systems, use the largest size Kiwi Slide that will fit the foil groove.

For Mainsail use, Kiwi Slides are designed to replace older style slugs or boltropes as used with "in mast" luff grooves, choose the largest size Kiwi Slide that will fit the luff groove.

Position Kiwi Slides such that there is a 3/8" – 1/2" space between the slug and the luff edge.

The following applies to Headsail Installation for Reef-Rite Furler Only

<u>DO NOT</u> place a Kiwi Slide in the following area above the tack grommet. (measured from inside bottom of grommet)
